APPLICATION

The Night Spirit is rugged and lightweight night vision monocular. It utilizes multicoated optics specially coated to gather light to provide bright and clear images. Couple these optics with state of the art quality image intensifier tubes and the Night Spirit is an excellent compact pocket scope. The Night Spirit is an amazing combination of versatility, performance, and price.

The Night Spirit night vision monocular is a complex electro-optical system for individual use. The device consists of the objective lens assembly, eyepiece and the body. The body contains an image intensifier tube assembly with an integrated high voltage power source and the battery housing.

Objective lens protective cover is intended to protect the objective lens from dust and scratches. It also acts as a daylight filter, allowing you to test the scope in daylight or other bright light situations. The pinhole in the center of the protective cover allows the user to check the operation ability of the device in daylight conditions.

The headgear of goggle kit secures the goggles to the user's head for night viewing, and provides freehand support for use with a weapon, protective mask or other purposes. It is adjustable and cushioned.

NOTE: Do not test the scope in daylight conditions even with the daylight filter/lens cap on for more than ten (10) minutes.

BATTERY INSTALLATION



Install standard AA batteries as follows:

- 1. Unscrew the battery cap[1].
- 2. Insert AA battery[2], observing the polarity as indicated.
- 3. Replace the battery cap and screw cap hand tight.



Install CR123A batteries as follows:

- 1. Unscrew the battery cap[1].
- 2. Screw the CR123 battery adapter[3] in to the cap.
- 3. Insert the battery[4], observing the polarity as indicated.
- 4. Replace the battery cap and screw cap hand tight.

OPERATION


Take the monocular out of the case.

Rotate the operation knob from "OFF" position to "ON" position to turn the unit on. The protective lens cover shall be attached to the lens. Do not turn the unit on in daytime without the protective lens cap on. You should see green glow in the eyepiece.

Observe the scene and adjust the diopter for optimal image clarity.

You may now enter a dark environment or simply shut the lights off in order to darken the room.

Next, remove the lens cap/daylight filter. Adjust the front lens focusing. You should not have to readjust the diopter. Remember that focusing range starts from 3 m.



To turn the unit off, rotate the operation knob from "ON" to "OFF" position.

FOCUSING

To focus the Night Spirit first you will need to adjust the diopter. Simply turn the diopter clockwise until it stops. Then, while looking through the diopter at an object, slowly turn the diopter back counter clockwise until the grain on the image becomes sharp.

NOTE: We suggest that you focus the diopter during daylight with the filter on.

Next focus the front lens until the image and the grain become both sharp. When you are in low-light conditions and the daylight filter is off, you may focus the front lens to receive sharp image, the diopter should not be adjusted.

NOTE: The front lens should be readjusted as you view objects at different distances.

BUILT-IN INFRA-RED ILLUMINATOR

Infra-red illuminators, or IR illuminators, are common to night vision. The IR light greatly enhances the performance of the Night Spirit while remaining almost invisible to a naked eye.

To turn the built-in IR on, draw and rotate the operation knob to "IR" position.

It is important to remember that the IR illuminator is simply an infra-red light source, and like any light source, it may loose its effectiveness over a great distance.



FLIP-UP HEADSET (OPTIONAL)

The headgear of goggle kit secures the goggles to the user's head for night viewing, and provides freehand support for use with a weapon, protective mask or other purposes. It is adjustable and cushioned.

OBJECTIVE LENS REPLACING

Replace the standard 3X objective lens of Night Spirit to the 1X lens for using with headgear.

CAUTION: Make sure that the unit is turned off.

Unscrew the standard 3X objective lens and screw 1X lens to the free place.


FITTING THE HEADGEAR

- 1. Fit the headgear to your head size. Adjust the headgear first before attaching the Night Spirit to it.
- 2. Loosen all the straps and place the headgear on your head.
- 3. Tighten the straps until the headgear fits firmly.
- 4. Remove the already adjusted headgear from your head.


Now you are ready to mount the Night Spirit on to your headgear.

UNIT INSTALLATION AND ADJUSTMENT

- 1. Push button [2] and insert the bracket [4] of the transfer piece [6] to the rail of the headset [3].
- Adjust an estimated eye relief.
 There are two threaded holes [9] in the transfer piece. Change position of fixation thumb-screw[8] to other hole for eye relief adjustment.
- 3. Install the Night Spirit onto the transfer piece. Screw the fixation thumbscrew [8] of the transfer piece into the mount hole [10] of unit body.
- Choose the angular position of unit for right or left eye. Loosen the angular fixation knob [5]. Adjust monocular angular position. Tighten the fixation knob.
- 5. Place the headgear with Night Spirit onto your head.



- Loosen the knob [7] and move the unit along the rail [3] for precise eye relief adjustment. Fixate the knob [7] in the needed position.
- If you need increase the eye relief of your goggles additionally, you can displace the bracket on the top of transfer piece.
- 7. Unscrew the screw [14] and detach the end-cap [13] from the bracket of transfer piece.
- 8. Unscrew the 2 screws [12] and detach the bracket from the transfer piece.
- 9. Turn the bracket 180 degrees.
- 10. Screw the 2 screws [12] back into place.
- 11.Put the end-cap [13] on to the place. Screw the screw [14] in to the place.



FLIP-UP MECHANISM

The Night Spirit headset has a flip-up mechanism. Push the button [1] on the side of mount and lift the unit up until the unit fixates in the top position. Push same button to lower Night Spirit to viewing position.

WARNING: It is critical that the goggles be turned off manually before placing them in the flipped up position in order to avoid detection by the enemy.

PICATINNY MOUNT ADAPTER WITH 1X LENS (OPTIONAL)

The Night Spirit may be mounted behind a variety of daytime night vision compatible holo/reflex sights (i.e. EOTech or Aimpoint) utilizing the Picatinny mount adapter with 1x lens.

WARNING: Do not use non-night vision compatible sights. May cause damage to night spirit. This damage is not covered by warranty.

To mount Night Spirit perform the following:



- Replace the standard 3X objective lens of Night Spirit to the 1X lens for using with headgear.
- 2. Mount the cleat to the body of Night Spirit.
- 3. Loosen the clamping knob on the weapon mount. Position the monocular mount onto the weapon's mounting rail, behind daytime sight adjust the fore/aft position of the monocular as necessary by loosening the clamping knob and repositioning the weapon mount on the rail. Tighten by turning the clamping knob.
- 4. Align the monocular and the weapon mount. Slide the monocular rearwards until the alignment boss aligns with the alignment groove on the weapon mount. Push until the monocular locks into the weapon mount.

SCOPE ADAPTER MOUNT WITH 1X LENS

(OPTIONAL)

The Night Spirit may be mounted to a variety of daytime scopes/telescopes utilizing the Scope Adapter Mount.

- Replace the standard 3X objective lens of Night Spirit to the 1X lens for using with headgear.
- 2. Loosen the adapter fixing screws [1].
- Put the insert into the adapter (ATN supplies inserts of different sizes for their coupling with 38 mm to 43 mm eyepieces).



- 5. Push a daytime riflescope or telescope eyepiece into the adapter attached to the monocular, making sure a small space is left between the scope eyepiece and the monocular front lens.
- 6. Tighten the adapter screw [1] securely.

WARNING: Do not use with illuminated reticle daytime scopes. May cause damage to night spirit. This damage is not covered by warranty.

450 MW INFRA-RED ILLUMINATOR (OPTIONAL)





Infra-red (IR) Illuminators are common for night vision technology. The IR light greatly enhances the performance of your device, while remaining almost totally invisible to the naked eye. Staying in the dark, switch on your night vision device. If the visibility is low, you may use ATN IR450 to improve the situation. Still, you should remember that the IR illuminator is just a source of infrared light so the greater is the chosen range of observation, the lesser its brightness becomes.

IR450 Infrared Illuminator can be mounted with PS-22 onto the Picatinny Rail, Platform Ring, BAM system or on to the weapon bases.

IR450 Installation:

- 1. Attach the IR450 adapter to the Night Spirit. Screw the screw of adapter into the mounting thread of device.
- 2. Place the IR450 onto the rail of adapter. Screw the fixing nut of IR50 mount tightly.





The ATN IR450 is powered with one CR123A lithium battery. To install the battery unscrew the cap of the battery housing and insert the battery following the polarity arrows marked on the housing. Put the cap in place.

The IR-450 illuminator has a control panel with two buttons. To switch the IR illuminator on/off press "+" and "-" buttons simultaneously. When the IR illuminator is switched on you can see the green LED lit on the back side of IR450. By pushing the buttons "+" and "-" you may adjust the IR brightness.

The IR beam is focusable to change the field of coverage. To change the beam width slightly turn the IR lens.

You may need adjust the focusing of the IR beam to change the field of coverage. Do it by slightly rotating the IR lens. The windage and elevation screws help adjust the direction of the IR beam from the IR450 in order to focus on the scene observed in the viewfinder of your NVD. Use the included Allen wrench to rotate the adjusting screws until the IR beam is centered. Please remember the adjustments should be performed under night light conditions only.

5X LENS (OPTIONAL)

The additional 5X Lens for Night Spirit transform it to 5X night vision monocular.

To install 5X lens unscrew the objective lens of Night Spirit and screw 5X Lens instead of it.



CAMERA ADAPTER (OPTIONAL)

To use your Night Spirit with a 35 mm camera or camcorder you will need the following:

- 1. If you plan to use a camcorder then your camcorder must have a MACRO feature. Most modern camcorders today have a MACRO feature built-in.
- 2. If you plan to use a 35mm camera, you will need a MACRO lens. If you don't have one, we advise that you contact your local camera store.
- You may or may not need a STEP-UP or STEP-DOWN ring in order to adapt the camera adapter to your lens. NOTE: The camera adapter comes with 37 mm and 52 mm threads. If you need other sizes your local camera store should be able to help.

Remove the rubber eyecup from the Night Spirit.

Screw the camera adapter onto the front of the lens on your Video camera's lens or your 35mm camera's lens.

Loosen the three set screws on the camera adapter.

Place the camera adapter over the Night Spirit's eyepiece.

Tighten the three set screws to fit snugly to the Night Spirit's eyepiece

You may need to focus the 35 mm camera or video camera in combination with the Night Spirit in order to get the sharpest possible image.

We suggest that you find an open space to work in. Focus the Night Spirit so that the scene is at its sharpest. For best results you should disable the auto focus (if any) on either the 35mm camera or the video camera and manually focus the 35mm camera or the video camera. Once the image is sharp, then simply adjust the Night Spirit's front lens to change focus.

* An important part to remember is that you are not taking a picture of an object that is far away from you, but you are actually taking a picture of a phosphorous screen of the Night Spirit that is only 2-3 inches away.

STORAGE AND CARE

- If the device will not be in use for extended period of time (more than 10 days) remove the battery.
- Avoid touching of lenses. If fingerprints or traces of dirt or dust appear, clean their surface with a Photographic lens cleaning tissue.
- Keep lens cap/daylight filter on when not in use.
- The Night Spirit is not harmful to the user or the environment.
- Do not disassemble except to clean the front lens and eyepiece: it will void your warranty.
- Evaluate the scope functionality by looking through it in a lit environment with the daylight filter lens cap on. Never use in daylight without the daylight filter lens cap on.
- Never point the Night Spirit at a bright light source.
- Adverse atmospheric conditions such as fog, smog, or haze and a lack of ambient light (moon or starlight) may diminish the effective viewing distance.
- If you use the rubber eyecaps for a long period of time, you may suffer skin inflammation. If you develop any symptoms, consult a doctor immediately.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- Q: Flashes, flickers, or clicking occur while operating
- **S:** If it occurs within the first five minutes of inserting new batteries, it is normal and the device will resume normal operation soon thereafter. If it occurs for more than 10 minutes, contact for service instructions.
- Q: Dark spots on screen.
- S: These are either cosmetic blemishes in the intensifier tube or dust particles.
- Q: Screen becomes darker than at previous use.
- **S:** Replace batteries. If problem persists, contact your dealer or other authorized service representative for service instructions.
- Q: Image not clear.
- S: Adjust objective lens, and/or the eyepiece.

TUBE MAINTANANCE/REPLACEMENT

Tube maintenance/replacement is to be performed by qualified technicians only. These procedures attempted by non-qualified personnel will void warranty.

- 1. Unscrew the eyepiece [6] from the case of device [1].
- 2. Unscrew the lock ring [5] from the case of device.
- 3. Extract the ring [4] from the case of device.
- 3. Extract the light guide [3] from the case of device.
- 4. Extract the tube [2] to be replaced from the case of device [1].
- 5. Introduce the new tube [2] into the case of device [1].
- 6. Set the light guide [3] onto the place in the case.
- 6. Set the ring [4] onto the place in the case.
- 7. Screw the lock ring [5] into the case of device.
- 8. Screw the eyepiece [6] into the case of device [1].



2 YEAR PRODUCT WARRANTY
